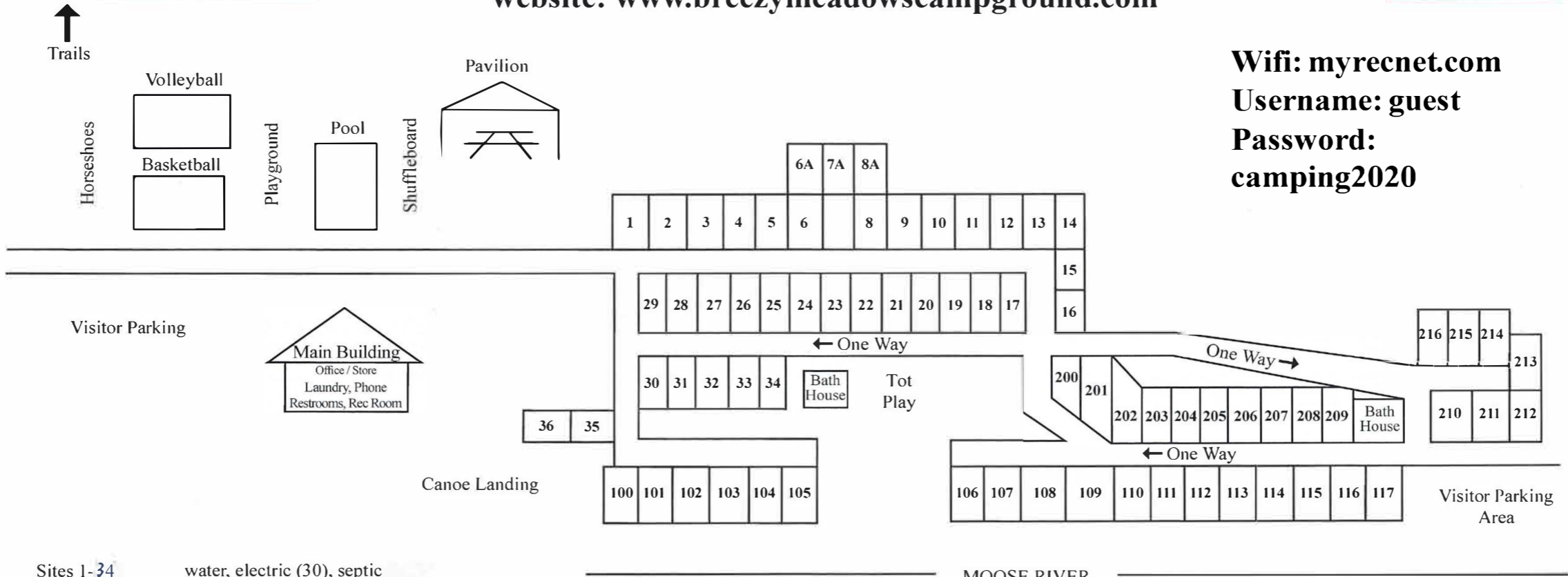

## At The Site

- Please park no more than two (2) vehicles per site.
- ALL VISITORS PARK IN VISITOR PARKING
- You are welcome to move your picnic tables as you wish.
- Please DO NOT move fire rings
- Please protect out trees, refrain from cutting of breaking branches.
- Please separate bottles, cans and trash. We shall pick trash up each AM.  
Please leave trash at the edge of road.
- Please do not wash vehicles at site.
- Please extinguish fires before retiring or leaving site.
- Please provide adult supervision for young children.
- Please do not throw waste in fire rings.
- Quiet hours are 10:00 PM til 8:00 AM

## Out and About

- Please remain on roads or walks. Please do not cross other's sites.
- Please ride bikes on roads and trails only
- Please utilize exterior sink at comfort station for dishes etc.
- Please provide adult supervision for children younger than sixteen (16)  
after dusk.

## Pets

- Please maintain reasonable control of your pets at your site.
- Please utilize a leash away from site.
- Please ensure your pets security and comfort while you are away from  
your site
- Please clean up after your pet at site and throughout the park!

## Alcohol

- Please consume alcohol responsibly at your site and throughout the  
park. Park management retains the right to limit consumption as  
needed to ensure the comfort and safety of all guests.

- Please instruct your guests to register upon arrival
- Day guests Free ( \$3.00 swimming fee)
- Overnight guest \$4.00 adult \$3.00 Child
